Word problems · Three-step — Answer key



1. $11 \times 10 = 110$, then 110
 $+ 3 - 20 = 93$ plums

2. $55 + 16 + 29 = 100$, then
 $100 - 25 = 75$ plums

3. $63 + 12 + 14 = 89$, then
 $89 - 29 = 60$ apples
